Five warlocks—each with a distinct magical power—have banded together to save the earth. Written and illustrated by Barry Blair. On sale every month.



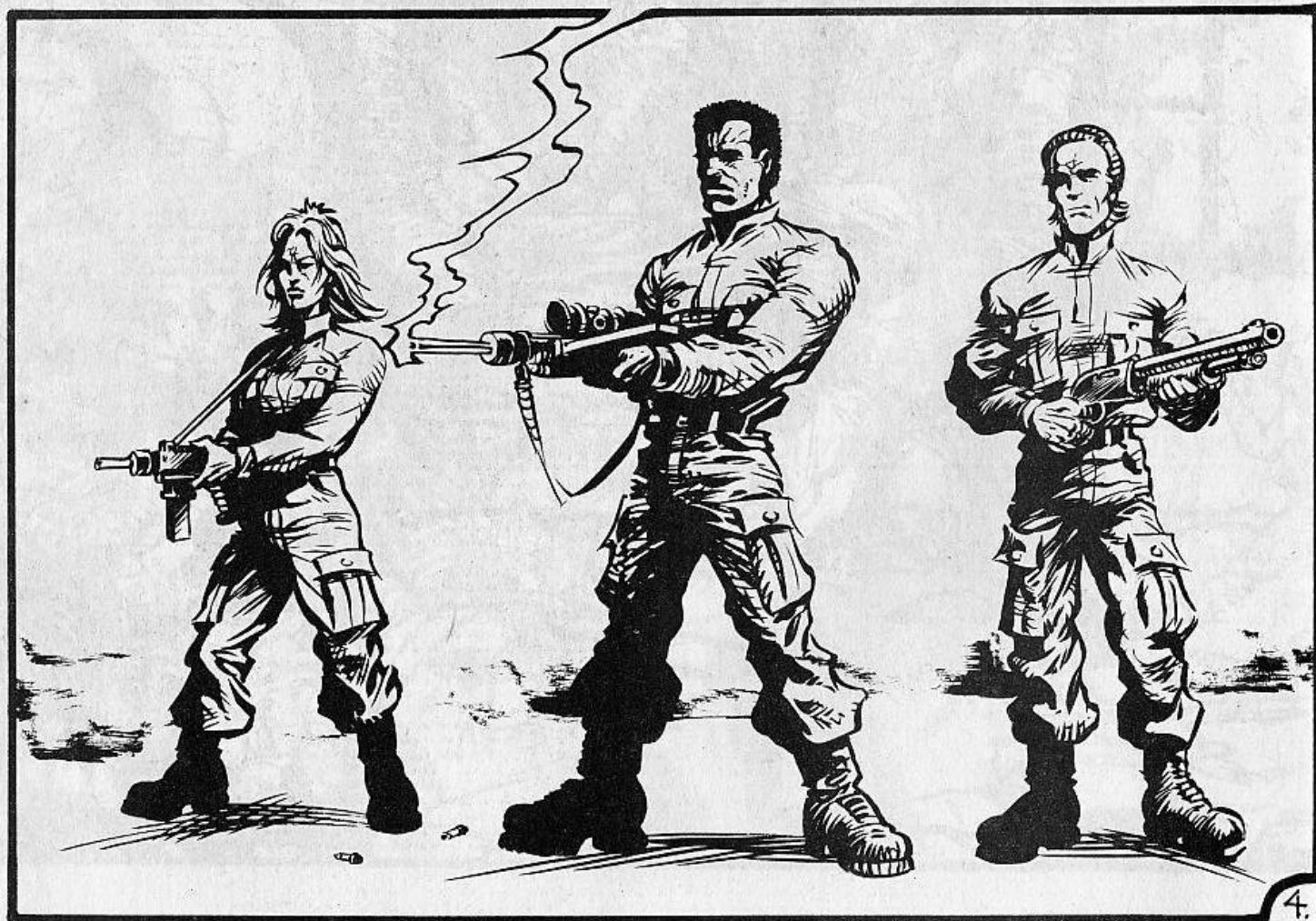
